Relevant experience of key project personnel with comparable facilities and/or infrastructure projects; 4. Ability to advance the project in the required time frame including provision of sufficient staffing in the appropriate disciplines; 5. EEO policy statement including M/WBE Utilization Plan and Diversity Practices Questionnaire; and other criteria which may be unique to this particular project. Submissions will be evaluated to assess the proposer's responsibility, project specific landscape architect / site civil engineering experience, percentage of sub-contracting, and financial stability.
