# **Getting There**

#### **Hudson River Park's Pier 40**

## W. Houston Street and the Hudson River – Greenwich Village

Take the 1 to Houston Street. Walk west and cross West Street/9A and head to the walkway at the South end of the building.

Landmarks and Conveniences: Pier 40 Picnic House, 4 acres of Sports Fields, Batting Cages, and Parking Garage.

#### Hudson River Park's Piers 45 & 46

## Christopher Street and the Hudson River - Greenwich Village

Take the 1 or Path to Christopher Street. Walk west and cross West Street/9A.

Landmarks and Conveniences: Christopher Street fountain, restrooms and snack bar.

# **Hudson River Park's Pier 54**

## 14th Street and the Hudson River - Meatpacking District

Take the A, C, E, to 14th Street OR take

the M14 bus to Tenth Ave and 15th Street. Cross West Street at 14th and walk south.

Landmarks and Conveniences:

Pier 54: Arch at entrance way to the Pier

# Hudson River Park's Pier 64, Pier 66 and Pier 66a Maritime

# 26th Street and the Hudson River- Chelsea North

Take the M23 or M14 Bus straight to Chelsea Piers OR take the C, E to 23rd Street, walk west, cross 12th Ave. at 22nd Street.

Landmarks and Conveniences:

Shaded Seating, and Gardens. Pier 66a Maritime: Maritime artifacts, Boathouse, Historic Vessels, and Food Concession.

## **Hudson River Park's Pier 84**

## 44th Street and the Hudson River

Take the M42 bus to the Hudson River or take the A, C, E to 42nd Street and walk west and cross 12th Ave at 43rd Street.

Landmarks and Conveniences: Pier 84: Contains a restaurant, boathouse, bike rental and fountain.

(Located between Circle Line Cruises 42<sup>nd</sup> St. and the Intrepid Sea-Air-Space Museum)

Hudson River Park's Piers 95 and 96 - Clinton Cove

55<sup>th</sup> Street – Hell's Kitchen

Take the A, C, B, D, 1 Subway to 59<sup>th</sup> Street/Columbus Circle, leave the station following the signs toward 57<sup>th</sup> Street. At the corner of 57<sup>th</sup> and Broadway, take the M57 Cross town Bus heading west to the 57<sup>th</sup> Street and 11<sup>th</sup> Avenue stop. Walk 2 blocks south to 55<sup>th</sup> Street and make a right, cross the West Side Highway at the cross walk and enter Hudson River Park's Clinton Cove.
