# FREE OUTDOOR MOVIES IN HUDSON RIVER PARK: Hudson RiverFlicks Lineup Announced for Summer 2019

Hudson River Park is opening the season with a special Heritage of Pride screening on June 21<sup>st</sup>, and will officially kick off on July 10<sup>th</sup> and run through the end of August. Movies will start at 8:30 PM or dusk – whatever comes first – and free popcorn will be served on a first come, first served basis.
