HUDSON RIVER PARK PRESENTS PUMPKIN SMASH AT PIER 84 ON NOVEMBER 7

Annual Pumpkin Smash event invites New Yorkers to bash post-Halloween pumpkins for compost

NEW YORK (November 2, 2021) — Hudson River Park announced today that its annual Pumpkin Smash will take place at Hudson River Park's Pier 84 on November 7. The event offers the local community an opportunity to smash and bash their leftover Halloween pumpkins into small pieces that will be turned into compost by Park staff.

Kids of all ages can partake in the fun from 11am to 2pm on Sunday, November 7 at Pier 84 near W 44th St and Twelfth Ave. Each group will get 15 minutes to pulverize their pumpkins into smithereens – the first step in the composting process. During Pumpkin Smash last year, the Park collected 1,000 pounds of pumpkin that were turned into compost by Park staff. Hudson River Park runs a community composting program year-round, operating ten drop-off sites where community members can deposit food scraps daily, 365 days each year. Composted food waste helps reduce harmful carbon emissions by reducing the need for waste to be shipped outside of New York City on gas-guzzling vehicles or barges that release carbon dioxide into the atmosphere. In addition, composted soil enriches the Park's lawns and flowerbeds and provides protections against pests and disease. Pumpkin Smash provides a unique and engaging way for the community to learn about how composting helps the overall health of both the environment and the Park.

"Hudson River Park's annual Pumpkin Smash event perfectly combines two aspects of Hudson River Park's mission: environmental stewardship and fun," **said Noreen Doyle, President and CEO of Hudson River Park**. "By encouraging our community to smash, bash and crash their leftover pumpkins into compost, we can all play an active role in working towards a greener future."

Pumpkin Smash is hosted by Hudson River Park with support from BASIS Independent Schools.
