**OVERNIGHT WORK OPERATIONS ON ROUTE 9A BIKEWAY FROM
WEST 57th STREET TO BATTERY PLACE IN MANHATTAN**

**BEGINNING ON OR ABOUT MONDAY NIGHT, MARCH 13th THROUGH
FRIDAY MORNING, JUNE 30th FROM
9 PM TO APPROXIMATELY 5 AM EACH MORNING**

The New York State Department of Transportation (NYSDOT) is advising the public that there will be overnight work operations as part of the ongoing maintenance of the Route 9A Bikeway from West 57th Street to Battery Place, beginning on or about Monday night, March 13th through Friday morning, June 30th from 9:00 p.m. to approximately 5:00 a.m. This work will be completed in sections of several blocks at a time, beginning with various locations between Warren Street and West 54th Street.

Please note that both bicycle lanes will be diverted into an overnight lane closure on the boulevard during work operations. Flag persons will be stationed at the ends of the work zone to manage bicycle and pedestrian traffic.

Please be mindful of flag persons and other workers as you proceed through the work zones.

These overnight work operations will facilitate the temporary removal of bollards, placement of temporary concrete barriers, pavement milling, paving, line striping and the re-installation of bollards for the NYSDOT project resurfacing the Route 9A Bikeway in Manhattan.

Thank you for your patience and cooperation as NYSDOT continues to improve our transportation infrastructure in New York City.
