AN ACT to amend the Hudson river park act, in relation to authorizing
a marine transfer station and environmental education center on
the Gansevoort peninsula

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and
Assem- bly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Subdivision (b) of section 3 of chapter 592 of the laws
of 2 1998, constituting the Hudson river park act, is amended to read
as 3 follows:
4 (b) "Compatible governmental use" means a use within the park that
is 5 compatible with park use in accordance with the purposes of this
act, 6 such as necessary and appropriate sewage, utility, and
ventilation 7 connections, and private utilities, including the repair,
maintenance, 8 operation, and replacement thereof; public safety facilities
necessary 9 for the maintenance and operation of the park; the marine company
one 10 fire boat station on pier 53; ~~and~~ the city of New York department
of 11 sanitation water-dependent marine transfer station on pier 99; and
the

12 city of New York department of sanitation water-dependent marine
trans-
13 fer station on the Gansevoort peninsula, including the
construction,
14 reconstruction, restoration, operation, maintenance, repair,
and
15 replacement thereof. Such transfer station shall be used to
process
16 recyclable materials and, in addition, shall contain an
environmental
17 education center.

18 § 2. Paragraph (d) of subdivision 9 of section 7 of chapter 592 of
the
19 laws of 1998, constituting the Hudson river park act, is amended to
read
20 as follows:

21 (d) Upon the relocation of any incompatible governmental uses,
the
22 Gansevoort peninsula, or any portion thereof from which such
incompat-
23 ible governmental uses are removed, shall be used solely for park
use

24 (of which at least eighty percent shall be passive and active
public
